

Going Home After Your Cardioversion

Today you have had a Cardioversion. Performed by Dr.

There are few things you need to watch for after you go home.

Eating

You may eat normally, unless otherwise directed by your doctor.

Medication

Continue with your regular medications, unless otherwise directed by your doctor.

Sedation

You were given sedation (medication to help you relax) during your Cardioversion. For a period of 24 HOURS you must NOT:

- Drive
- Operate Machinery
- Drink Alcohol
- Make any major or legal decisions
